INTRODUCTION:

The gospel of Matthew is the first book of the New Testament. It is named after one of the 12 apostles of Jesus. Matthew, also known as Levi, was a tax collector before he left his work to follow Jesus. His name means “gift of the Lord”. Matthew, inspired by God, wrote this book to tell about the life of Jesus. Although written in Greek, Matthew’s main readers were Jewish. His main purpose in writing is to prove that Jesus *is* the promised Messiah as demonstrated by his fulfillment of the Old Testament prophecies. Matthew immediately identifies Jesus with the royal throne of David in the first verse of the book, thus showing Jesus Christ as the King. The word “kingdom” occurs over 50 times, thus emphasizing that Jesus came to earth to establish a kingdom and to exercise authority as a king in that kingdom. Matthew is the only New Testament writer to use the term “Kingdom of heaven”. Sixty percent of the gospel contains the spoken words of Jesus, which is organized in five main teaching sections:

- 4 – three temptations; begin to preach and heal; first disciples follow
- 5 – beatitudes; salt, light, fulfill law, murder, adultery, divorce, oaths, eye for eye, love for enemies
- 6 – give, pray, fast, treasures, worry
- 7 – judging, seeking, 2 gates, fruit of a tree, builders
- 8 – healings: leprosy, centurion’s servant, Peter’s mother-in-law, 2 demon-possessed men, many. Cost of following; calming the storm
- 9 – healing a paralyzed man, sick woman, blind and mute; Matthew follows; fasting (garments and wineskins); few workers

- 10 – 12 apostles listed and sent out to preach and heal
- 11 – John the Baptist asks questions; unrepenting cities; rest for weary
- 12 – Sabbath controversy; Beelzebub; Jonah; Jesus' family
- 13 – Parables: sower, weeds, mustard seed, yeast, hidden treasure, pearl, net; rejected by hometown
- 14 – John beheaded; 5,000 fed; walking on water
- 15 – clean or unclean?; Canaanite woman wanting crumbs; 4,000 fed
- 16 – demanding a sign; guarding against Pharisees and Sadducees; Peter confesses; Jesus tells of his death to come
